### ABOUT GAP GROUPS:

#### Description:

GAP Groups provide a casual atmosphere for child welfare professionals to participate in a guided/facilitated discussion of a particular topic in child welfare. The GAP session is most often a 3 hour session, but may be shorter or longer depending on the topic. Training credit is provided as an OCWTP approved trainer or other subject matter expert facilitates and contributes to the discussion.

#### Format:

Through guided discussion, the facilitator will encourage conversation and the sharing of experiences surrounding the relevant topic. Participants have the opportunity to learn from the experiences of others as well as be able to share their own experiences. The primary mechanism for learning will be accomplished through the guided discussion of participant experiences.

#### Intended Outcome:

A greater sense of confidence in one's own knowledge, skills and abilities as well as the creation of a county and regional informal support network.
